

How to Read This Report:

Colors indicate statistical significance (95% confidence level) – meaning the result is mathematically proven to be different from other groups, not just a random fluctuation.

Light Green: Notable difference.

Dark Green: Strong, reliable trend.

Dark Blue: Extreme outlier / High-impact demographic trend.

Gold: High-impact finding – >50 % with 6 + groups outperformed.

Letters identify which column is outperformed. Significance tested at the 95% confidence level ($p < 0.05$).

* Base too small to report. Columns with fewer than 30 unweighted interviews show no percentages; their base counts are still listed so the size of the group is visible.

A letter list ending in + has more columns than the cell can display; the letters shown are the first few, not the complete list.

Multiple-comparison correction: Bonferroni. This adjusts alpha to control the family-wise error rate.

Sample Size Advisory:

If a column has an "n" of less than 50, treat the data as a "suggestion," not a fact. Colors are lightened to reflect lower confidence.

If the n is under 30, the sample is too small for reliable conclusions and the column reports no percentages at all.
